DUTY OF CARE (OWED TO GOODS)



LOCATION

MUST BE WITHIN REASONABLE DISTANCE
FROM THE PLACE WHERE CONTROL WAS
TAKEN OF GOODS.



INVENTORY MUST BE INCLUDED

REMOVE GOODS AND SECURE ELSEWHERE

KEY POINTS AND CHANGES:

- **The Act now introduces a new statutory duty of care to the goods. An enforcement agent must take reasonable care of controlled goods that he removes from the premises.**
- **The notice of the removal of goods must include specific details about what goods have been removed, where the goods have been removed to and contact details for the enforcement agent.**
- **An inventory must be included in the notice.**
- **The location of the removed goods must be within a reasonable distance from the place where control was taken of the goods.**
